ARRETE MUNICIPAL N° 2026-042

Regulations Governing the Motorhome Parking Area

The Mayor of the Municipality of Rodemack,

Having regard to the French General Code of Local Authorities, in particular Articles L.2212-2, L.2213-1 and L.2213-2;

Having regard to the French Highway Code, in particular Articles R.411-25, R.417-10 et seq.;

Having regard to the French Criminal Code;

Considering the need to ensure public safety, traffic convenience and the protection of municipal public property;

Whereas the parking of motorhomes, campervans and buses is regulated throughout the public areas of the Municipality, and prohibited outside designated locations, the Municipality of Rodemack, with the support of the Cattenom et Environs Community of Municipalities, has established a parking area made available free of charge for motorhome users.

In return, users are expected to respect the site, local residents, municipal facilities and local businesses, all of which contribute to the attractiveness and quality of the welcome offered by the Municipality.

ARRÊTE

Article 1 – Purpose

This parking area is intended exclusively for the temporary parking of motorhomes, campervans and similar recreational vehicles.

Use of the parking area constitutes unconditional acceptance of these Regulations.

Article 2 – Conditions of Access

The parking area is open throughout the year unless otherwise decided by the Municipality or in exceptional circumstances.

Access is reserved for vehicles:

- in good working condition;





- complying with all applicable regulations;
- covered by valid insurance.

Access is prohibited for:

- vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) exceeding 3.5 tonnes;
- vehicles exceeding 8.50 metres in length;
- converted residential vehicles whose overall length exceeds the marked parking bays;
- vehicles registered as "bus" or "coach", including those converted for residential use, where such category appears on the vehicle registration certificate.

The Municipality reserves the right to refuse access to, or require the removal of, any vehicle failing to comply with these conditions.

Article 3 – Exemptions

These Regulations shall not apply to:

- public service vehicles;
- emergency service vehicles;
- vehicles carrying out authorised works;
- vehicles benefiting from written authorisation issued by the mayor.

Article 4 – Maximum Length of Stay

The maximum permitted stay is **72 consecutive hours**.

Upon expiry of this period, the vehicle must leave the parking area.

A new stay shall only be permitted after a minimum period of 7 days.

Article 5 – Exceeding the Maximum Stay

The maximum authorised stay is 72 consecutive hours.

Any stay exceeding this limit may constitute unlawful prolonged parking within the meaning of the French Highway Code and may result in the issuance of a penalty notice, vehicle immobilisation or impoundment in accordance with the applicable legislation.



Article 6 – Use of Parking Bays

Vehicles must park only within the designated parking bays shown on the site layout.

The following are prohibited:

- occupying more than one parking space;
- obstructing traffic circulation;
- parking on grassed areas or outside designated parking spaces.

Article 7 – Conduct and Public Order

Users shall respect the peace and quiet of local residents and other users.

The following are prohibited in particular:

- excessive noise;
- use of loud audio equipment;
- any behaviour liable to disturb public order.

Quiet hours shall be observed **between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.**

Article 8 – Camping Equipment

This site is a parking area and not a campsite.

Unless expressly authorised by the Municipality, the following are prohibited:

- pitching tents;
- installing permanent awnings;
- erecting fences or fixed equipment;
- occupying communal areas with bulky furniture.

The reasonable use of tables and chairs immediately adjacent to the vehicle may be tolerated provided it does not inconvenience other users.

Article 9 – Waste and Wastewater Management

Users shall keep the site clean at all times.



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The Municipality provides separate waste collection:

- recyclable packaging and similar recyclable materials must be deposited in the yellow-lid container;
- glass, paper and cardboard must be deposited in the dedicated recycling containers located within the village;
- non-recyclable household waste must be deposited in the green-lid container.

The following are strictly prohibited:

- littering;
- discharging grey water or black water anywhere other than the designated disposal facilities;
- releasing pollutants into the natural environment.

Article 10 – Water and Electricity Supply

The Municipality provides, free of charge, access to drinking water and an electrical outlet.

The drinking water supply may only be used to fill the vehicle's fresh-water tank or for on-site consumption. It is strictly prohibited to use this water point for any other purpose, including vehicle washing or irrigation.

Electricity is provided for a few minutes per vehicle solely while using the waste disposal station. The use of extension leads to obtain a continuous electrical connection is strictly prohibited.

Article 11 – Animals

Pets are permitted under the responsibility of their owners.

They must remain on a leash throughout the parking area and while travelling within the municipal boundaries.

Owners must immediately collect and dispose of animal waste.

Article 12 – Safety and Liability

Users Park entirely at their own risk.

The Municipality shall not be held liable for:





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- theft;
- vandalism or damage;
- accidents;
- damage caused to persons, animals or property.

Each user shall remain personally liable for any damage they may cause.

Article 13 – Specific Prohibitions

The following are prohibited:

- lighting fires directly on the ground;
- using open-flame barbecues during periods of fire risk;
- carrying out major mechanical repairs;
- washing vehicles;
- storing equipment outside the vehicle.

Article 14 – Penalties

Failure to comply with these Regulations may result in:

- a request for immediate compliance;
- exclusion from the parking area;
- notification to the law enforcement authorities;
- application of the penalties provided for by the legislation in force.

Any breach of this By-law shall be recorded and prosecuted in accordance with the French Highway Code and may give rise to the penalties provided for under Articles R.417-9, R.417-10 and R.417-11 thereof, without prejudice to vehicle immobilisation or impoundment where legally applicable.

Article 15 – Entry into Force

These Regulations shall enter into force on the date they are displayed at the motorhome parking area.





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The Mayor shall be responsible for enforcing this By-law, a copy of which shall be forwarded for information to the Commander of the Hettange-Grande Gendarmerie.

The Mayor reserves the right to amend these Regulations at any time in order to ensure the safety, cleanliness and proper operation of the parking area.
